

What were the causes of WWI?

NATIONALISM

Many nations competed for power and pride; others wanted independence for their people

- ❖ France – wanted revenge against Germany for taking Alsace and Lorraine in 1871
- ❖ Germany – united in 1871 & became powerful; wanted to increase its power by getting more territory
- ❖ Austria-Hungary – Serbians wanted independence from Austrian rule

IMPERIALISM

As a result of industrialization and nationalism, European nations competed for colonies

- ❖ Moroccan crises (1905 & 1911) – France and Germany competed for land in Africa

MILITARISM (& THE ARMS RACE)

National competition led nations to build up their militaries

- ❖ France – wanted revenge against Germany so doubled size of its military
- ❖ Britain & Germany – competed for most powerful navy

ALLIANCES

Like in gangs, because of alliances, small fights could turn into big ones when everyone got involved

- ❖ Triple Alliance (1882) – Germany, Austria-Hungary, Italy
- ❖ Triple Entente (1907) – Britain, France, Russia
