

## **Movement for European Unity**

*political unif. fail / economic unif. succeed*

2 orgs grew out of the Marshall Plan. Both are based in France:

- Org. of European Econ. Cooperation [OEEC] (1948) to work on post-WWII recovery. Became OECD in 1961. OECD has 34 members (inclu. non-Europe), seeks to stimulate econ progress and world trade.
- Council of Europe (1949) – 10 members originally, now 47. Hope was this would become a Euro parli but GB opposed. Now its purpose is to promote democracy and human rights.

More econ orgs:

- Coal and Steel Community (1952-2002) – tariff- and quota-less coal and steel market, 6 members
- **European Econ. Community / European Community / Common Market** (1958-1993) – replaced Coal and Steel Community; promote free trade, free flow of labor and capital, common econ policies
  - set up by **Treaty of Rome (1957)**
- **European Union, EU** (1993-present) – replaced Common Market ... serves as single market for Europe
  - **Maastricht Treaty (1991)** – est. € (2002)
